Downtown Lincoln Parking Information Available to State Tournament Attendees

Lincoln, NE – The Downtown Lincoln Association (DLA) and the City of Lincoln say there is ample parking for attendees visiting downtown Lincoln during State Volleyball and State Football tournaments. Downtown Lincoln is home to 22 visitor parking facilities which include approximately 18,000 parking spaces. Information, including maps, locations and rates of parking facilities, can be found at the downtown Lincoln parking web site, www.parkitdowntown.org or by calling (402) 434-6900. Attendees are encouraged to park in off-street lots or garages since parking meters have enforced time limits. Parking brochures can be downloaded off the web site or picked up in downtown parking garages or at the Downtown Lincoln Association at 1200 N Street, Suite 101.

Founded in 1967, the Downtown Lincoln Association was originally established as a merchants' association by downtown retailers who recognized the need for an organization to serve downtown's unique needs. DLA has evolved to a multi-faceted organization supporting a wide range of programs and activities including maintenance, economic development and advocacy. DLA is also the umbrella for Updowntowners, Inc., downtown's events production arm and the Downtown Neighborhood Association. The association works closely with the Lincoln Haymarket Development Corporation to support Haymarket revitalization and attractions.
